Choosing a Confirmation Sponsor

What is a Sponsor?

A sponsor is a person who encourages and assists a candidate to embrace and actively practice the Catholic faith before and after Confirmation. The sponsor also presents the candidate to the Bishop (or his delegate) at the celebration of Confirmation.

Who can be a Sponsor?

Being a sponsor is not just an honour. The sponsor must be an active, practising Catholic who can be a role model for the candidate. Ideally, you should choose one of your godparents from Baptism, provided he or she meets the above guidelines. If it is not possible to choose a godparent as your sponsor (e.g. they are deceased, live too far away, or are no longer a practising Catholic), then you might ask someone else whom you see as an example of committed, practising Catholic. This could be a grandparent, aunt, or uncle, other relative, family friend, parent of one of your friends, a teacher.

The requirements of the Catholic Church say that a sponsor.

- May be a man or woman (Sponsors do not have to be the same sex as the candidate.)
- Is a person who regularly comes to Sunday Mass and celebrates the sacraments
- Must be fully initiated Roman Catholic (Baptized, Confirmed and has made First Communion)
- ➤ Must be at least 16 years old
- ➤ May not be the parent of the candidate.
